Cookies Policy

Policy Statement

This Cookies Policy explains how Family Link uses cookies and similar technologies on our website and how you can control them. This policy should be read alongside our Privacy Policy.

Family Link is committed to protecting your privacy and complying with UK data protection law, including the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR).

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, tablet or mobile device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work efficiently, improve user experience and provide information to website owners.

Cookies can be:

- Session cookies – which are deleted when you close your browser
- Persistent cookies – which remain on your device for a set period or until you delete them

How we use cookies

Family Link uses cookies to:

- Ensure the website functions correctly
- Remember your cookie preferences
- Understand how our website is used, so we can improve it

We do not use cookies for advertising, profiling, or selling personal data.



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Types of cookies we use

Essential cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to work properly. They enable core functionality such as security, accessibility and remembering your cookie preferences.

Essential cookies are always active and do not require your consent.

Analytics cookies (optional)

We may use analytics cookies (for example, Google Analytics) to help us understand how visitors use our website.

These cookies collect information such as:

- Pages visited
- Time spent on the website
- How visitors arrive at the site

The information is collected in an anonymised and aggregated way and does not directly identify you

Analytics cookies will only be used if you give your consent via our cookie banner or settings.

Managing your cookie preferences

When you first visit our website, you will see a cookie banner that allows you to:

- Accept optional cookies
- Reject optional cookies
- Change your cookie preferences at any time

You can withdraw or change your consent at any time by adjusting your cookie settings on our website.



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Controlling cookies through your browser

You can also control and delete cookies through your web browser settings. Most browsers allow you to:

- See what cookies you have
- Delete cookies
- Block cookies from specific websites
- Block all cookies

Please note that disabling cookies may affect how the website functions.
